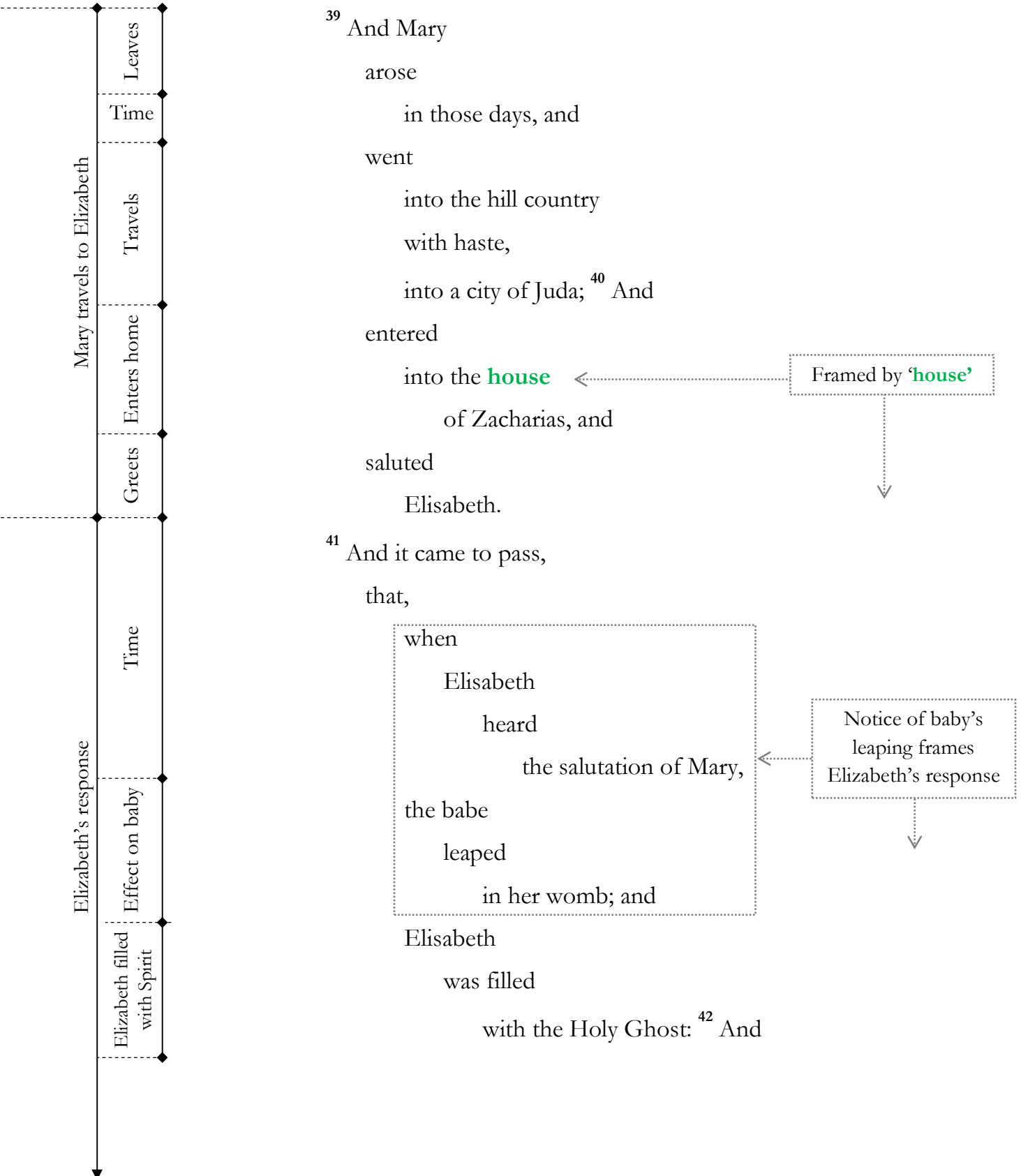
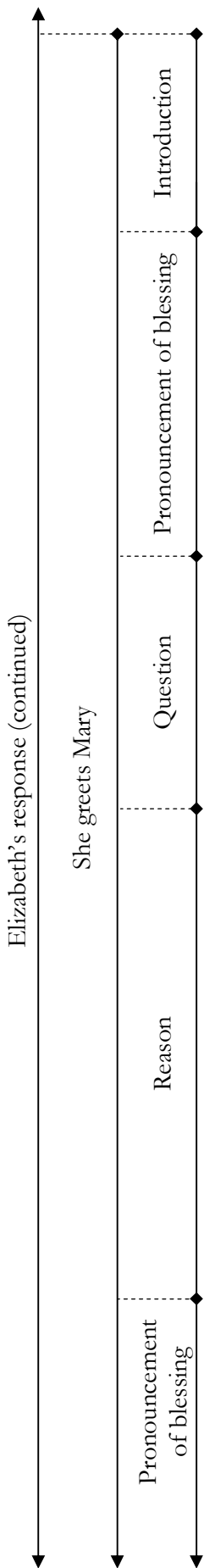

## Meeting of the mothers - Transition to Panel 2





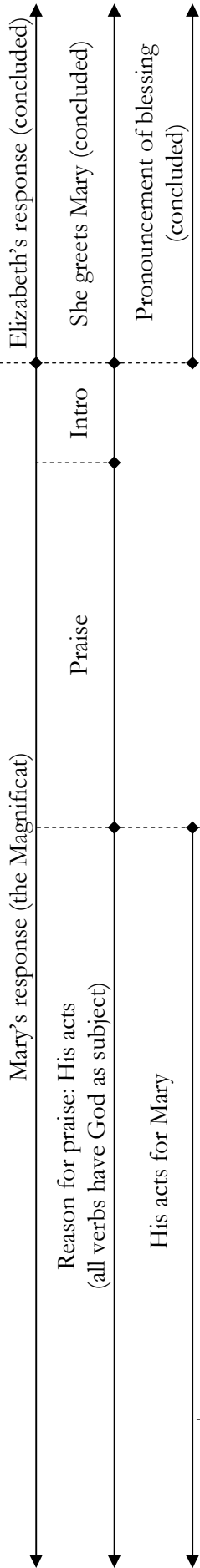

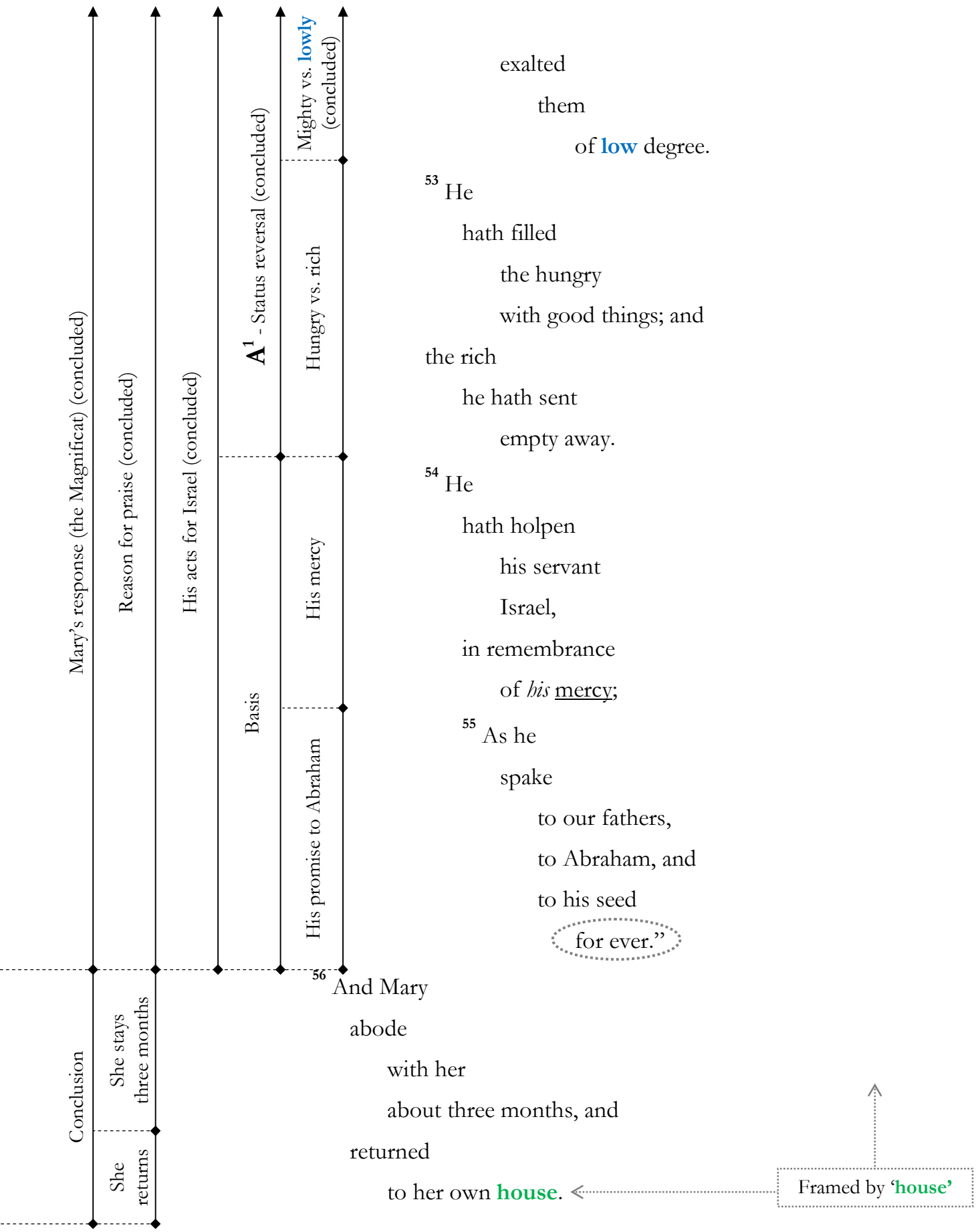
