INTRODUCTION: THE SKILL OF WAITING

A milestone in your walk with Jesus is gaining the ability to do nothing when you could easily do something. The Bible calls it waiting.

Exodus 14:13, 14

But Moses said to the people, "Do not fear! Stand by and see the salvation of the Lord, which He will perform for you today; for the Egyptians whom you have seen today, you will never see them again, ever. The Lord will fight for you, while you keep silent."

Isaiah 64:4

For from days of old they have not heard or perceived by ear, Nor has the eye seen a God besides You, Who acts in behalf of one who waits for Him.

Proverbs 20:22

Do not say, "I will repay evil"; Wait for the Lord, and He will save you.

The unfaithful are unwilling to wait for God to work. They turn to other things that might solve their problems.

? How do you sit back and wait for God to work?

The key to waiting is simple. Know God.

Psalm 37:12-26 teaches us three truths about God that make it possible, even desirable to wait rather than act for ourselves.

I. THE MASTER SEES THE END OF THE WICKED, VV. 12-15

A. THE MASTER SEES

- 1. The Pride Of The Wicked
- 2. The End Of The Wicked

Proverbs 16:4

The Lord has made everything for its own purpose, Even the wicked for the day of evil.

- B. THE ARMS OF THE WICKED WILL BE BROKEN, v. 17a
- 1. The Wicked Will Perish, v. 20a
- 2. The Wicked Will Vanish Like Grass And Smoke, v. 20b
- 3. The Cursed Will Be Eliminated, v. 22b

II. YAHWEH CARES FOR YOU WHEN YOU'RE MOST NEEDY, VV. 16, 17

? Why is the little better than abundance?

? How does God work that out?

A. YAHWEH SUSTAINS THE RIGHTEOUS, v. 17b

He will give you all you need to survive on this earth.

Matthew 6:25ff.

B. HE KNOWS (CARES FOR) THE DAYS OF THE BLAMELESS, vv. 18, 19

- The Righteous Have Plenty Now And Forever
- a. Their inheritance is forever
- b. They will not be ashamed in evil days
- c. They have plenty in days of famine
- 2. The Righteous Is Gracious And Gives, v. 21b

Psalm 112:5

It goes well for a person who is gracious and lends; He will maintain his cause in judgment.

Proverbs 11:24

One gives freely, yet grows all the richer; another withholds what he should give, and only suffers want.

III. YAHWEH ESTABLISHES YOUR STEPS, VV. 23-26

Proverbs 20:24

A man's steps are ordained by the Lord; How then can a person understand his way?

(Proverbs 16)

He realizes that God establishes his steps for a good end. (Romans 8:29)
