## 3. Rebellion's Remedy – Isa. 1:16-26

- I. Reformation vs. 16-20
  - A. Reformation of Self (16-17a)
    - 1. Wash appears 73x in OT, 52x in reference to ceremonial cleansing through the sacrificial system they are abusing and have corrupted
    - 2. Make yourselves clean (purify yourselves) James 4:8-10; Heb. 9:12-14
    - 3. Put away (take away) evil doings
    - 4. Cease (Stop) your old way of living (repent)
    - 5. Learn to do good (new priorities and practice believe, faith that works)
    - 6. Seek justice/righteousness conforming to God's revealed will (obedience)
  - B. Reformation of Society (17b) James 1:27
    - 1. Rebuke (set straight/right) the Oppressor
    - 2. Defend (stand for justice) the Fatherless
    - 3. Plead (argue, quarrel, debate the case of) for the widow
  - C. Reason over Sin (18-20)
    - 1. An imperative to be obeyed (a summons)
    - 2. Let us reason a command, not a negotiation or plea bargain, "argue it out" to be admonished or reproved
      - a. Sin is unreasonable
      - b. Man can only be reasonable when he acts and thinks in accordance with God's Word and will
      - c. Reason Together = discuss the accusations and see if the Accuser (God) is willing to extend mercy, then submit to the dictates He lays down
      - d. He is willing, so if they refuse then their destruction is on them
    - 3. From deepest blood red stain/dye to the purest white of snow and wool (justification)
    - 4. The Conditions
      - a. If you are willing (consent, agree, yield do the demands)
      - b. And Obedient (hear, listen, and obey)
    - 5. The Consequences
      - a. If you refuse to reason/repent
      - b. And rebel (disobey)
      - c. You will be devoured by the sword judgment
  - D. The Mouth of the Lord has Spoken Rev. 2:16; 19:11-16
- II. Reversal vs. 21-23
  - A. Adultery (21) Moral Collapse
    - 1. Infidelity, Idolatry
    - 2. Injustice
    - 3. Unrighteousness
  - B. Adulteration (22) Economic Collapse
    - 1. Impurity from pure silver to only dross
    - 2. Dilution finest wine "cut" with water, not recognizable
  - C. Association (23) Societal Collapse Psa. 34:14; Deut. 10:17; Psa. 119:63; Prov. 13:20; 28:7; 1 Cor. 5:11; 2 Thess. 3:14; 1 Cor. 15:33

- 1. Inward rebellion of leaders
- 2. Outward companions of thieves
- III. Restoration vs. 24-26
  - A. The Absolute Master of All (24a) power and strength in protection turned to power and strength in judgment Ezek. 5:13
  - B. Relief and Revenge (24b) Nahum 1:2; Hebrews 10:30
  - C. Refiner's Fire (25) turn against to bring back Amos 1:8; Jer. 6:9; Ezek. 38:12; Psa. 81:15 salvation requires purging
  - D. Righteousness Restored (26) after captivity Neh. 1:3-11
