- 1. What stood out to you from the sermon?
- 2. How does the passage demonstrate Paul's awareness of God's sovereignty in his trials? How has knowing that God is sovereign over all things—including your trials—helped you in difficult circumstances?
- 3. How does the passage demonstrate Paul's awareness that he's a recipient of grace for both salvation and service? Do you view yourself as a steward of the gifts God has given you? How would that perspective change the way you approach the various roles and responsibilities the Lord has given you?
- 4. How important is the Church in God's plan? What is God's purpose for the Church?
- 5. In verse 12 Paul says believers have bold access to God the Father. What is the basis for our access? Do you approach God in prayer *with confidence*? Why or why not?
