Understanding Yokes

A contrivance used from ancient times, by which two animals, especially oxen, are coupled together for drawing a plow or vehicle

It is held on the animal's neck by a U-shaped oxbow that also transmits force from the animal's shoulders. A swivel beneath the centre of the yoke attaches to the pole of the vehicle or chains that are used to drag the load.

A similar appliance anciently placed on the neck of a captive or conquered enemy

Verb: to hold in subjection or servitude
