- II. David continues, in the text, to celebrate the great things God has done and expresses why He trusts in the Lord through the hardships and difficulties of life.

I. What They Are

- A. David praises Jehovah God for His wonderful works. What are these works?

- B. The text also speaks of the thoughts of God. (Gen. 50:20; Eph. 1:11)

II. How They Are Described

- A. They are more than can be numbered.

- B. Not only are they so great because of how many, but also because of weight of these works.

III. What They Result In

- A. The text is explaining why we trust in the Lord.

- B. Those who trust in the Lord are blessed. This means literally happy.
