## Introduction...Relevance and Connectedness...

- 1. The purpose of Christ's miracles is to teach us important Gospel truths...
- 2. Christ came to save us from our sins and deliver us from the awful consequences of the fall
- 3. The miracle of calming the storm demonstrates Christ deliverance of His people from the dangers and fears of this life... *Hebrews 2:15*

## I. The Timing and Circumstances of the Miracle... Matthew 8:23 cf. Mark 4:35

- A. The Popularity of Jesus had been growing... Matthew 4:25; 8:1
- B. The Days were full of Activity...
- C. They were days of wonder and confusion... Matthew 8:27
- D. It was at night...
- E. A Storm arose upon the sea...
- 1. It was all of a sudden... Note Matthew says... "Behold..."
- 2. It was a great (violent, frightening) storm...

Observations: 1. Christ can lead us into stormy seas...

- 2. The Lord tries our faith for a good purpose... see II Corinthians 1:8-10
- 3. We should not grieve the trial, rather our half-heartedness in the trial...
- 4. It is a great blessing to be with Christ in the storm... I Peter 4:14
- II. <u>A Clear Presentation of The Christ who worked the Miracle...</u> Matthew 8:24 cf. Mark 4:36-37
- A. We see His real Humanity...
- B. He Never ceased to be God...
- C. Yet He slept in the storm...

**Observation:** His real humanity was never a hindrance to His care for His church nor was it a contradiction to His Divine nature.

Consider *Psalm 121:4* 

- III. The Little Faith of His Disciples and the Miracle... Matthew 8:25-26
- A. They had a Defective (limited) View of Christ... See Mark 4:30
- B. Here is A Word of Encouragement...
  - 1. Be thankful for faith...even little faith is saving faith...
  - 2. Pray for faiths increase...
  - 3. Nurture faiths growth...
