When things are made holy, when they are consecrated, they are set apart unto purity. The are to be used in a pure way. They are to reflect purity as well as simply apartness. Purity is not excluded from the ide of the holy; it is contained within it. But the point we must remember is that the idea of the holy is never exhausted be the idea of purity. It includes purity but is much more than that. It is purity and transcendence. It is a <i>transcenden purity</i> " (57; emphasis mine).
