- B. Who is Satan?
  - 1. He is a created being (Ps 148:5, Col 1:16)
  - 2. He has intellect, emotion and will (1Co 11:3, Rev 12:17, 2Tim 2:26)
  - 3. He is called *ha satan* (Job 1:6-12, Zech 3:1, Mt 4:10)
  - 4. The devil diabolos (Matt. 4:1; 13:39; Eph. 4:27; Rev. 12:9; 20:2)
  - 5. **Lucifer** *light bearer* (Is 14:12, 2 Co 11:14)
  - 6. **Anointed cherub** (Ez 28:14)
  - 7. **Evil one** (Mt 13:19, 38; Jn 17:15; Ep 6:16; 1 Jn 5:18,19)
  - 8. **Ruler of this world** (John 12:31; 14:30; 16:11)
  - 9. Prince of the power of the air (Eph. 2:2)
  - 10. Serpent (Gen. 3:1; 2 Cor. 11:3; Rev. 12:9; 20:2)
  - 11. **Dragon** (Rev. 12:3, 7,9)
  - 12. Accuser of the brethren (Rev. 12:10)
  - 13. **Tempter** (Matt. 4:3; I Thess 3:5)

  - 1. Is the devil relevant?
  - 2. Is this a theme that will turn off intellectuals?
  - 3. Satan would love nothing more than for the church to ignore him
    - a. Remember Pearl Harbor

- B. Genesis 2:8-17, 3:1-6 (striving with man from the beginning)
- C. Satan's origin Ezekiel 28:11-19
  - 1. Satan's pride Isaiah 14:13-14
  - 2. Satan's rebellion Rev 12:4
  - 3. Satan's demise Is 14:12, Ez 28:16-17, Rev 20:10

### IV. A brutal foe

- A. He is an **invader** 
  - 1. of *individuals* (Legion and Judas)
  - 2. of the church (Mt 13:25, 2 Cor 11:26, Gal 1:6-9, Ro 10:1-3, Mk 13:22-23
- B. He is a **thief** (Mk 4:15)
- C. He **opposes** your ministry (Zech 3:1, 1 Thess 2:18)
  - 1. He opposed Christ from beginning to end (Lk 4:2, 22:44)
  - 2. He opposed Paul in Ephesus (1 Cor 16:8-9, Acts 19:8-40)
- D. Satan's plan is to conform you into his image
  - 1. but ... James 4:7 (Submit to God, and resist the devil and he will flee)

## V. A cunning foe

- A. 2 Corinthians 11:3, 13-15 (an angel of light)
- B. John 8:44 (The father of lies)
- C. Satan's lie that he himself believes
- VI. **Conclusion:** *In light of the formidable nature of our enemy, how then are we to stand?* 
  - A. 1 John 3:8 (Christ destroyed the works of the devil)
  - B. Romans 8:31-37 (we ARE more than conquerors through him)
  - C. Colossians 2:14-15 (Christ defeated Satan at the cross)
  - D. John 12:31-33 (Satan was judged in the cross)
  - E. Acts 2:32-36 (this crucified Savior is risen and is both Lord and Christ)
