## **Building Christ's Church Matthew 16:13-20**

## Main Point:

You have a significant part to play in the building of Christ's church; therefore, with confidence in His promise, do your utmost to build on behalf of your Savior.

1. Despite what others believe, Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God.

2. As the Christ, Jesus is building His church.

3. Jesus Christ builds His church through your proclamation of His gospel.

4. Nothing can stop Jesus' church from being built.
