WHEN GOD SEEMS FAR AWAY – Psalm 13v1-6 GCBC – AM Sermon: 09 – 08 - 2020

INTRO:

ILLUST: - Christ' Disciples; Storm at Sea & Their REACTION – Mk. 4v32

Intro: Book Of Psalms & Text.

OBSERVE: Three (3) Emphases:

I. DAVID'S APPREHENSIONS; CAUSED BY THE ANGUISH OF HIS SOUL – 1&2

Observe four (4) concerns:

- 1. God has <u>FORGOTTEN</u> Me v1a "how long, o lord? will you forget me forever? (v.1a)
- 2. God Has <u>FORSAKEN</u> Me v1b "how long will you hide your face from me? (v.1b)
- 3. God Has Abandoned Me To The Futility Of Self Reliance v2a "how long shall I take counsel in my soul, having sorrow in my heart daily? (v.2a)
- 4. God Will NOT Fulfil His Promises; BUT Am Frustrated By Them "how long will my enemy be exalted over me?" (v.2b)

II. <u>DAVID'S APPEAL FOR GOD'S REASSURING</u> <u>PRESENCE (3 & 4)</u>

- a) Spiritual Dimension: "Consider (Look at me) and answer me O LORD my God!" v3a
- b) Emotional Dimension: enlighten my eyes (Light up my eyes) = bring me hope and joy... (Dark thoughts and lost in sorrow)
- c) Physical Dimension: "Don't let me be shaken..." v4

III. DAVID'S APPECIATION OF GOD'S

TRUSTWORTHINESS (v5&6) c.f. Lam. 3v23 "great is thy faithfulness"

Let's break David's praises in areas of emphasis:

- i) He Recalled God's Unfaltering Compassion (Verse 5a) "But I have trusted in Your Lovingkindness" v5a
- ii) He Recalled God's Unfailing Faithfulness v5b "...steadfast love (ESV)" Or mercy, unfailing love, v5a (Implied thought) c.f. Lam. 3v23 "great is thy faithfulness (Ps. 57v10 & 108v4) PS> Rom. 3v4 (let God be true, and man, a liar) (Ps. 25v10, 26v3, 36v5, 40v1 11; 85v10; 86v15; 115v1; Prov. 16v6

Concerning David, God said: II Sam. 7v15 ". C.f. Ps. 89v24, 28,33

Concerning David's Posterity: Isa. 55v3 "...according to the faithful mercies shown to David"

- iii) He Reaffirmed/Reasserted God's Unbounded Joy Of Salvation & His Sufficiency "My heart shall rejoice in Your salvation." v5b c.f. Romans 8v35–39 READ:
- iv) He Resolved To Take Ease, In God's Manifold Generosity/Kindness/Grace

"I will sing to the LORD, because He had dealt bountifully with me"-v6 c.f. $\underline{2}$ Samuel $\underline{7}\underline{v8}$ - $\underline{9}$, & $\underline{15}$ – $\underline{16}$ (NASB)

CONC/APP:

- 1. Relate To God by Conviction/ Confident Assurance & NOT just by feelings (v1-2)
- 2. Be real with yourself; Before God As His Child -(1-4)
- 3. Always: remind yourself Of God's faithful promises -(5-6)
- 4. Always: Ascribe glory to God, b/c of His gracious dealings with us-6b **Amen.**
