Sermon Outline for Sunday, August 14, 2022

Sermon: "Boaz is Not Sampson." Ruth and Covenant Survival. Pt.4

I Text:

Old Covenant: *Ruth 2:1-13*

New Covenant: *1 John 4:7-21*

II Doctrine:

After the arduous journey with her mother- in- law, Ruth now seeks to provide food for them. With the permission of Naomi she seeks to glean from the fields of Boaz, Naomi's wealthy kinsmen.

When Boaz finds out who Ruth is he deals honorably with her. He gives instructions for his servants to protect her in every way. They are also told to ensure she is allowed to glean enough food for her and Naomi.

Ruth asks Boaz why he has dealt so gracefully with her. He tells her because she is a woman of honor, in the way she has dealt with her mother- in- law and the people of Israel.

III Comparing Scripture With Scripture:

1) After the arduous journey with her mother- in- law, Ruth now seeks to provide food for them. With the permission of Naomi she seeks to glean from the fields of Boaz, Naomi's wealthy kinsmen. (*Ruth 2:1-3*)

2) When Boaz finds out who Ruth is he deals honorably with her. He gives instructions for his servants to protect her in every way. They are also told to ensure she is allowed to glean enough food for her and Naomi. (*Ruth 2:4-9; 1 John 4:7-21*)

3) Ruth asks Boaz why he has dealt so gracefully with her. He tells her because she is a woman of honor, in the way she has dealt with her mother- in- law and the people of Israel. (*Ruth 2:10-13*)
