Review :

Last week, in part one, we learned of the five-fold method God used to bring his word from heaven to earth in the book called the Holy Bible. Jeremiah was *presented* the words by God's visitation; he then spoke them by *inspiration*. Baruch, the scribe, sat nearby and wrote *all the words with ink in a book*, v 18. That is called the process of *inscription*. Down through the centuries our Lord has providentially *preserved* his words using scribes to make faithful *copies* (e.g. Proverbs 25:1). Finally, during the *Philadelphian* period of the church (~ early 1500's - late 1800's), God used faithful saints to *translate* his words from both Testaments into a united Holy Bible in many languages. The result one *pure* (Proverbs 30:5) and *perfect* (Psalm 19:7) Bible in each language.

Today we will study the importance of reading God's Holy Bible. The saints of God have left us numerous examples of their faithfulness and devotion to the reading of sacred scripture.
