11.11.12.11. (Monk)

8 Owe no man any thing,
But love his neighbor;
He that conveys God's love
Does the law's labor.

9 For it is briefly said,
Also, if it is read,
Understood as thyself,
To love thy neighbor.

Thou shalt not kill or steal,
Is within love's law;
Bearing false witness too,
Love covers that flaw.
Adul'try thou shalt not
Commit for love has bought
Your soul, redeem'd by God;
Love thou thy neighbor.
