 - o with all dignity The pastor is one who understands the seriousness of the matter...
 - o **keeping his children submissive** the kids living at home are to submit to the orders and directions of their parents
- (Vs. 5) Without the demonstration of a submissive family, the church should question the pastor's ability to care for the broader church family
- (Vs. 6) Not a recent convert
 - o Subject to pride ("the condemnation of the devil")
- (vs. 7) Well thought of by others good reputation with unbelievers
 - o Subjected to the scrutiny from without (local community) and within (church family)
 - o Satan likes nothing more than to "snare" a man of God!
