      - 1. Leave your gift at the altar (Matthew 5:23-24)
    - iv. Practice authentic forgiveness
      - 1. Authentic forgiveness is costly (Matthew 5:39)
      - Authentic forgiveness relinquishes vengeance (Prov 24:29)
      - 3. Authentic forgiveness protects the reputation of the offender (Prov 11:13)
      - 4. Authentic forgiveness acknowledges God's sovereignty (Gen 50:20)
      - 5. Authentic forgiveness loves your offender and pray for his spiritual wellbeing (Matthew 5:43-48)
