Isaiah demonstrates what faith can do in times of political and national crisis by restating what God has already said He will do.

 - C. Lachich Burial Site SW of Jerusalem 15k bodies, Tyre, Philistia, Egypt
 - D. Hezekiah Offers Tribute 2 Kings 18:13-16
- II. Sennacherib's Offer <u>36:4-10</u>
 - A. Reliance on Egypt will Fail (vs. 4-7)
 - B. Can't Trust the Lord (removed high places) (vs. 7) $\frac{2 \text{ Kings } 18:4}{2 \text{ Kings } 18:4}$
 - C. Judah Lacks Manpower to Resist (vs. 8-9)
 - D. Assyria is on a Divinely Appointed Mission (vs. 10)
- III. Sennacherib's Blasphemy 36:11-21
 - A. Ignoring Officials to Speak to the People (politicians make wars, people fight and die in them)
 - B. Offers for Peace and Relocation
 - C. Don't Trust Hezekiah, or the Lord
 - D. Blaspheming the Lord of Hosts
- IV. Hezekiah's Panic -36:22-37:4
 - A. Repentance and Confession the end of human strength
 - B. Send for the Preacher tell him to pray!
- V. Isaiah's Reassurance <u>37:5-7</u>
 - A. Isaiah Does Not Pray
 - B. Isaiah Reiterates God's Promise
 - C. God Sends a Lying Spirit <u>1 Kings 22:21-23; 2 Thess. 2:11; Rev. 17:17; John 8:44</u> "Those who merit delusion are visited with error."
 - D. Judgment of the "Great King" (no mention here of army's destruction) see <u>Isa. 14:24-27;</u> 31:8; 2 Kings 18:32-37
