


“JESUS SPEAKS TO CHURCHES”

E. Getting too good at doing right; losing sight of the purpose and becoming orthodox testing machines; Christian Pharisees; love of being right; love of proving others wrong; love of helping in your own name; love of sacrifice for assumed merit; love of hard work for the recognition of the ideal of hard work, yours or someone else's; over-engaging in commitments thought to be improvements for the sake of the cause; enduring suffering or pain for the nobility of it; busy at the wrong things

F. Losing the prime love. What is the prime love?

- 1. Love the LORD your God with all your heart, soul, mind, strength and being*
- 2. Love your neighbor as yourself*
- 3. Justice, mercy and faith Matt 23:23; Micah 6:8*
- 4. Abiding in Christ because He is Christ*

G. Restoring the lamp's light

- 1. Remember from where you have come*
- 2. Repent (change your mind and direction) simplify your life by cutting out what is not for Christ; prune unproductive activity; motive*
- 3. Do the basics, the first works*

H. The great danger of a removed lamp

It is a grand privilege, a heavenly honor, to bear the light of Christ and an equally grand shame to be removed by Christ from that honor.
