I. Time –"forty days and forty nights" (vs. 27-28) *With a distinct set of:*

A. **People** – "I made a covenant with thee and with Israel"

C. Precepts – "words of the covenant...commandments"

II. Testimony –"the skin of his face shone" (vs. 29-33) *With a demonstrative:*

A. Presence - "they were afraid to come nigh him"

B. Partnership – "Aaron and all the rulers"

C. Practice - "he gave them...all that the LORD had spoken"

III. Thoughtfulness –"went in before the LORD" (vs. 34-35) *With a deliberate:*

A. Intimacy – "he took the veil off"

B. Instruction – "spake ... that which he was commanded"

C. Interaction – "the skin of Moses face shone"
