

Title: What God has done for us.

Passage: Philippians 2:5-8

Main thought: How did Christ suffer and how does that affect my life?

- II. Christ's Servanthood Philippians 2:7
Though he was from Glory, he was born to a poor family.
Though he was from Glory, he served others.
Though he was from Glory, washed the disciples feet.

Matthew 27:26-31; 45-50
- IV. The Resurrection
I Corinthians 15:17-22; 55-58

Conclusion: Christ left all the glory of Heaven to take the penalty of your sins, which was death. He rose again, conquering death and sin, and made a way for you to go to heaven. Have you accepted this sacrifice he made for you?
