Col 2.9-10 For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily; <sup>10</sup> and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power.

Now, having soared into the heavenly places with the writer look how practical life is to be. Notice how tangible their Christianity was to be.

- 1. Let there be **love** in the pews (v.1-6)
  - a. Love is **hospitable** (v.2)
  - b. Love is **sympathetic** (v.3)
  - c. Love is **committed** [Heb 13.4; <u>1 Co 6:18; Eph 5:5</u> -7]
  - d. Love is **content** (v.5-6)
- 2. Let there be **leadership** in the pulpit (v.7-9, 17, 24).
  - a. **Listen** to their teaching (v.7-9)
  - b. **Follow** their faith (v.7)
  - c. **Submit** to their leadership (v.17)
  - d. **Honor** their calling (v.24) Greet them?
- 3. Let there be **loyalty** in public (v.10-14)
- 4. Let there be sacrifices **personally** (v.15-16) Sacrifices was a major theme throughout the book. No more blood; no more animals; no more sacrifices need be made than Jesus. But there is something that God wants:
  - a. The fruit of our **lips**
  - b. The fruit of our <u>labor</u>
- 5. Let there be prayer **mutually** (v.18-21)
- 6. Let there be glory eternally (v.21)
- 7. Let there be grace **limitlessly**. (vr25)
