Exodus 26:1-14

Jesus is our:

I. Substitute – “fine twined linen...purple” (vs. 1-6)

Requiring Him to be:

A. Human – “being found in fashion as a man” *Phil. 2:8*

B. Humble – “humbled Himself, became obedient to death”

C. Holy – “He who knew no sin” *II Corinthians 5:21*

II. Scapegoat - “of goats hair to be a covering” (vs. 7-13)

Replacing condemnation with:

A. Cleansing – “atonement...to cleanse you” *Leviticus 16:30*

B. Communion - “be clean ...before the Lord”

III. Security - “a covering...of rams...badger skins” (v. 14)

Relying on His:

A. Strength – “kept by the power of God” *I Peter 1:5*

B. Sufficiency - “I give unto them eternal life” *John 10:28*

C. Sealing – “sealed with the Holy Spirit ” *Ephesians 1:13*

Sentence Sermon:

“When it comes to forgiveness and freedom, Jesus has us covered.”
