1. As a saint, you are being preserved to the end by God.

2. Nevertheless, by God's grace, you must persevere to the end.

3. Even though, you will be discouraged and tempted to quit at times, God is still preserving you.

4. Press on knowing that God is preserving you to the end.

**Definition**: The perseverance of the saints is the teaching of Scripture that those who are genuine believers in Christ will, by the work of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, persevere in faith and in bearing spiritual fruit until they go to be with the Lord, and thus will certainly be saved.

**John Wesley** "Those who live by faith in the Son of God; those who are sanctified by the blood of the covenant, may nevertheless so fall from God as to perish everlastingly."

WCF 17.2 This perseverance of the saints depends not upon their own free will, but upon the immutability of the decree of election, flowing from the free and unchangeable love of God the Father (Eph. 1:4); upon the efficacy of the merit and intercession of Jesus Christ (Heb. 9:11-15; Heb. 7:25); the abiding of the Spirit (1 John 2:27), and of the seed of God within them (1 John 3:9); and the nature of the covenant of grace (Jer. 32:40): from all which ariseth also the certainty and infallibility thereof.
