A Soldier's Testimony

1. Known sin must be addressed, so as not to forfeit the blessing of God (Joshua 8:1; 7:26; Acts 2:42; I Jn. 1:9; Prov. 28:13; Jer. 5:21-25; 6:16-19; 15:1,5,6; 3:12,13; 26:1-3)
2. God's promise to bless is no excuse to be lazy (8:1; Phil. 1:6; 2:12; Ps. 127:1)
3. The Lord is personally involved in the life of His people and my life (8:2,18)
4. When the Lord gives us a plan, we need to follow His plan (Ps. 119:60)
5. The Lord's person and promise is our confidence and encouragement (8:1,18)
6. The Lord's enemies are our enemies; we must always war against them (8:25,26)
7. God calls us to be a people who always remember (8:29)
