The protective ministry of angels is something that should bring comfort to us as we walk into the unknowns of each new day. God gives the angels instructions as to what must be done to safely guard us from fatal disaster. We should be thankful to God for this service. No doubt many are wondering, at this point in the study, just how it is that we are not protected in every instance.

We all know of Christians who have fallen victim to accidents, some even being killed. How can one account for such events in light of the angelic protection spoken of by the Bible? This is not an easy question to answer. In some cases, it is impossible to give an answer. But we must make some attempt. It must first be said that angels do only what they are told to do. In the second place it must be said that what they are told to do they cannot fail to do. So if protection seems to be missing on some certain occasion, then the problem does not lie in the lack of ability or willingness of the angel. Once commanded, they will always be successful in carrying out their mission, no matter how seemingly impossible. This truth is seen in their ability to protect the three from the fiery furnace, Daniel from the hungry lions, Elijah from being taken captive, and release of Peter from jail. The absence, at times, of protection goes beyond the angels. God's protection does not always mean a life free of any problems, pain or trouble. Though Peter escaped prison on one occasion, legend has it he was crucified many years later. What is promised the true followers of Jesus?

The protection given us by the angels is real and valuable. When ordered by God, the angels can work a miracle, if need be, to guarantee our safety. There is no reference in the Bible to one holy angel who failed to do what he was instructed to do. In our day and times, an automobile can be as vicious, and as much a threat to our safety, as any lion. God's protection is still a blessed privilege for the Christian. We can have angelic protection without our ever seeing the angel at work.

## **Third: Their Worship Ministry**

We have been looking at how angels serve man. Now we will consider how angels serve God.

Worship is of primary interest to God. The angels were created first and part of their duties from the start was to worship God. This work is still taking place. To get some idea as to what this worship is like we will look at several references in the Bible.

Artists often paint an angel as carrying a stringed harp in his arms. There can be little doubt that angels sing praise unto God. But there is no direct reference to the angels playing harps, or any other instrument. In Revelation 14:2-3 we read of John hearing music in heaven, which he compared to harpists playing on their harps. This music seemed to accompany some group singing a new song before God's throne. It is not said who is doing the singing nor how the music is made.

### **Fourth: Their Judgment Ministry**

When given the command, the angels of God could also carry out destruction upon those who resisted God and preferred a life of sin. Man was found to be no match for the power of angels when they carried out their work of judgment. The Bible contains many accounts of this special type of angelic ministry. We will consider only a few.

What were two angels able to do to a group of men living in Sodom who threatened the household of Lot? A closer examination of the Scriptures will reveal that this was not the cause for the fall of the wall. Before the Israelites ever started their marching around the city, Joshua had a visitor.
