Sermon Text: Daniel 1:1-21 Eating from the Lord's Table

In Christ God gives us what we need for His purposes.

- 1) God gives us trials to share in the suffering of Christ (1:1-7).
 - a) Verse 2, "And the Lord gave Jehoiakim king of Judah into [Nebuchadnezzar's] hand."
 - b) In Isaiah 28:21 "strange deed."
 - i) Discipline for sin
 - ii) Discipline for maturity
 - c) Christ's Crucifixion
 - i) God's Plan (John 19)
 - ii) Our Share (Phil. 1:29)
- 2) Second, God gives us grace to pursue holiness in Christ (1:8-16).
 - a) Holiness is consecration, or devotion to God.
 - i) Fruit of holiness—deeds
 - ii) Corollary of holiness—separation from evil
 - b) Verse 9"God gave Daniel favor and compassion in the sight of the chief of the eunuchs."
 - i) External Grace through others
 - ii) Internal Grace (Phil. 2:12-13)
 - c) The riches of Christ for our sanctification (Phil. 4:19).
 - d) God glorified as our Provider (Phil. 4:20).
- 3) God gives us wisdom to succeed in our calling in Christ (1:17-21).
 - a) "God gave them learning and skill in all literature and wisdom" (v. 17).
 - b) Vocation: From God, for God, through God
 - c) Who is sufficient for these things?
