

# The Courage to Stand Firm in the Battle

Eph. 6:10-18

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.

Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm.

Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace.

In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one; and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints.

Who and what is our enemy?

1. The schemes of the devil.

Put on the whole armor of God that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. (11)

“schemes” – strategies; tricks; deceptions; craftiness; wiles.

Satan disguises himself as an angel of light. 2 Cor. 11:14

Satan is always on the prowl seeking whom he may devour.

1 Peter 5:8

Satan – Lucifer was a chief angel that rebelled against God. (Isa.14; Ezek. 28; Rev. 12)

Jesus not only spoke about Satan

(Jn. 8:44)

Jesus spoke with Satan (Matt. 4:3-10)

Paul, Peter, James, John and the writer of Hebrews all refer to Satan.

In Scripture – We see Satan

- opposing God's work (Zech 3:1)
- perverting God's Word (Matt. 4:6)
- hindering God's servants (1 Thess. 2:18)
- blinding the world (2Cor. 4:4)

“Satan” – adversary (52 times)

“Devil” – slanderer (35 times)

2. The spiritual forces of darkness.

We can stand firm against the enemy  
if we stand...  
1. In the power of the Lord.

He who is in you is greater than He who is in the world 1 Jn. 4:4

Protection for the heart

Let us cast off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light.

Rom. 13:12

Put on the Lord Jesus Christ and make no provision for the flesh, to gratify its desires. (14)

- The shoes of the Gospel of peace (15)

... as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the Gospel of peace.

The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. Rom. 16:20

The Gospel brings power, victory, hope, love, grace, forgiveness and peace.

... To open their eyes, so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God.. Acts 26:18

Hudson Taylor Story (1832-1905)

- founded China Inland Mission

- 20 mission stations, 849 missionaries, 700 Chinese workers

- 125,000 Chinese Christ-followers (baptized 50,000 himself)

Chinese government commissioned an author to write a biography of Hudson Taylor in order to minimize his work and discredit Christianity.

In His research of Hudson’s life and the message of Christianity he renounced atheism

and received Christ!

- The shield of faith (16)

In all circumstances take up a shield of faith (16)

“shield” – 2 ½’ wide

- 4 ½’ long

... with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one. (16)

Flaming? – intent on destruction

- intent on spreading the destruction

- intent on creating fear

Darts? – arrows; missiles; specific weapon of attack

doubts; temptations; discouragement; envy; bitterness; pride; strife; hurt feelings; jealousy; materialism; anger; guilt; hopelessness.
