

# Marks of a Mature Faith

1 Corinthians 3:1-9

- I. A maturing Christian feasts on solid food, while an immature Christian still requires milk.
  
- II. A maturing Christian is others-directed, while an immature Christian cares only about self-interest.

III. A maturing Christian sees spiritual leaders as they are, while an immature Christian often falls prey to hero-worship.

a – Understanding that we are all God's servants.

b – Understanding that we all serve at God's discretion.

c – Understanding that we are all working toward the same goal.

d – Understanding that the product of our spiritual labors is owing to God, and belongs to God.
