 - d. To avoid destruction (v8, 10, 14, 16)
 - f. To stand before God (v1-2, 12)
- 3. Do we truly *value* biblical education?
 - a. How well do you *know* the Bible?
 - b. How well do you *understand* the Bible?
 - c. How well do you *apply* the Bible?
 - d. How well do you *teach* the Bible?
- 4. Challenge: Examine the priority of biblical training in your life.
 - a. You and the Word: Read, understand, apply, repeat.
 - b. You, others, and the Word: discipleship is the normative mode of the Christian life.
 - c. You, the world, and the Word: the next generation is hopeless without truth let's teach them!
