- What further purpose does Jesus have in our oneness (23b)?
- And what is the final end for all that Jesus is praying for His disciples (23c)?
- What is the final prayer request (24a) and its intended result (24b) and its basis (24c)?
- What does Jesus express He has done and will do in regards to His disciples (26a) and what is His intention in doing this (26b)?
- Community Group Discussion: What would you say must be at the heart of our lives as Jesus disciples today as those for whom He has prayed these prayers?
