- I. Prayer is a vital part of our covenant friendship with God.
- II. The third petition gives us rich instruction how to pray concerning God's will.

Praying God's Will Be Done

I. The Necessary Explanation

A. To understand the petition, we must understand from Scripture what God's will is.

B. When Jesus teaches us to pray, "Thy will be done," He is teaching us to be submissive to God's will for our lives.

II. The Way We Pray

A. The HC teaches us to pray, "grant that we and all men may renounce our own will."

B. Grant that we may obey God's will without murmuring.

III. The Covenant Assurance

- A. When David prayed to God, submitting to His will after discovering what that was from Nathan the prophet, what was his response? What brought him to submission?
- B. What an assurance for us also, as we learn to submit to God's will for our lives.
