This evening we come to better know the first petition to pray for the glorifying of God’s Name in our life in the prayers we bring before Him.

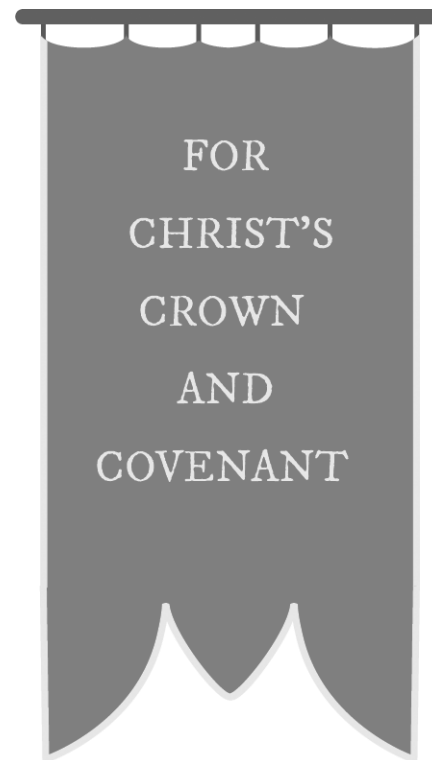
Pray...

- That our lives would be for the glory of God (1 Corinthians 10:13) and that we would highly esteem Him (Psalm 67:3).
- That our lives would be full of the fruits of righteousness to the praise and glory of God (Philippians 1:11).
- We would glorify God for disposing all things to His glory (Genesis 50:20).
- That those in Reformed Churches would hold onto faith and a good conscience, as some have made a shipwreck of their faith (1 Timothy 1:19)
- That the name of the Lord would be glorified and praised throughout the earth (Psalm 67, Psalm 83) by the work of Jesus Christ conquering hearts (Rev. 6:2)
- For the Lord to heal the nation’s deep divisions through a revival of faith in Jesus Christ (Galatians 3:28).
- For protection for the magistrates and police who are trying to keep order against growing lawlessness (Romans 13:4-5), and that justice would prevail in those areas where there are injustices in our nation (Psalm 33:5).
- For protection from the coronavirus (Psalm 91:3), and that it would abate.
- For a competent portion of those things we need in this life (Matthew 6:11), including food, work, and covering.
- For the Lord to raise up ministers of the gospel to go into the harvest (Matthew 9:38).
- Pray that the Lord would preserve our congregation’s lampstand (Rev 2:5) and witness to McKinney, especially in our transition.
- Pray for the church as she is persecuted and that she would have a godly witness (Matthew 5:10). Pray that the church in our nation would not be persecuted so we could live godly lives (1 Timothy 2:2).
- Pray for the increase of Christ’s Kingdom over the earth (Matthew 6:10).
- Pray for our congregation, that we would walk as befitting the sons and daughters of light (Ephesians 5:8), that the world would perceive us as His children and give glory to God.
- Pray for our families, that the Lord would preserve our families and call all of the covenant children to Himself (Acts 2:38), that they would not depart from the way in which they should go (Proverbs 22:6), and provide godly spouses for them.
- Thank Christ for His great care for us (Luke 22:40, 45) and for fulfilling all righteousness (Matthew 3:15) on our behalf.

Please continue to pray over these things through the week as a guide for your own personal and family prayers.

### **Larger Catechism Q. 190.** *What do we pray for in the first petition?*

*A.* In the first petition, (which is, Hallowed be thy name,) acknowledging the utter inability and indisposition that is in ourselves and all men to honour God aright, we pray, that God would by his grace enable and incline us and others to know, to acknowledge, and highly to esteem him, his titles, attributes, ordinances, word, works, and whatsoever he is pleased to make himself known by; and to glorify him in thought, word, and deed: that he would prevent and remove atheism, ignorance, idolatry, profaneness, and whatsoever is dishonourable to him; and by his overruling providence, direct and dispose of all things to his own glory.
