Without having all the details, you are to continue serving the Lord faithfully now, knowing that every day you are closer to your eternal rest.

1.	Your times are completely in God's hands (v. 5-7a)
2.	God's plan for you includes tragedy and then triumph (v. 7b)
3.	Under God, even your worst times are purposeful (v. 8-10)
4.	In Christ you are not only called to stand firm, you are enabled to stand firm in all circumstances (v. 11-12)
5.	Even when you do not understand every detail, you are to continue faithfully serving the Lord in humble anticipation of entering your eternal rest (v. 8, 13)
