A CHRISTIAN ON CAMPUS Acts 17:16-34

When did the world change? Attitudes and actions for Christians in a non-Christian world:

- Let's be <u>honest</u> with ourselves about the world we live in (v.16-21). The world is full of <u>idols</u>.
 - a. Our **eyes** should affect our heart (v.16).
 - b. Our heart should affect our will (v.17).
 - c. Our witness will be **examined** (v.18-21). Two philosophies:
 - i. Epicureans: **Enjoy** Life.
 - ii. Stoics: **Endure** Life.
 - iii. Expect to be ridiculed.
- 2. Let's be prepared to <u>talk to others</u> about the God we serve (v.22-31).
 - a. God is great: Creator (v.24).
 - b. God is **good**: Provider (v.25).

- c. God is **governing**: Ruler (v.26-29)
- d. God is gracious: Savior (v.30-31).
- 3. Let's be <u>clear</u>: a personal decision must be made about Jesus (v.32-34).
 - a. Some will **mock** the gospel, especially the resurrection.
 - b. Some will **delay** some wanted to mull it over.
 - c. Some will believe.
