A. A BEGINNING PROMISE (Proverbs 3:5-7)

There are 4 parts to this promise from God:

1. Your part: " *in the* *with all your heart.*"
2. Your part: "*And* *unto your own* *.*"
3. Your part: "*In* *your ways* *.*"
4. God's promise: "*And He* *your* *.*"

B. A BASIC PREMISE (John 7:17)

There are 4 parts involved in this premise:

1. God has a ... "*His will*".
2. God wants you to His will... "*he shall know*".
3. God's will is revealed in His ... "*concerning the doctrine*".
4. You must to God's will in order to know God's plan explicitly... "*If anyone* *His will*".
