a. why a blood sacrifice?

Lev. 17:11; Heb. 9:22

- b. Passover sacrifice
 - Christ identified as the Lamb Jn. 1:29; 1 Cor. 5:7
 - Christ died on our behalf as the Lamb Heb. 10:4; 1 Pet. 1:18-19
- c. Day of Atonement sacrifice
 - single offering for the people Lev. 16
 - *means* of the atonement:
 - result of the atonement: 1 Pet. 2:24
