### A. Beggars and a Blind Man Arrive - v. 22

Bethsaida Julius -

A blind man - *toof-los'* - o\_\_\_\_\_. Blind.

T\_\_\_\_\_ of Christ - Mark 1:41; 3:10

### B. Sight to the Blind - v. 23-25

1. The B\_\_\_\_\_ of Sight
  - a. R\_\_\_\_\_ for the Work - v 23a
  - b. Christ's M\_\_\_\_\_ to the Man - v. 23b
  - c. Vision has b\_\_\_\_\_ - v. 24

"looked up" *an-ab-lep'-o* - (anah - up or about; blepo - to look or see) -  
Mark 10:52; Matt 11:4-5; Act 9:12

2. C\_\_\_\_\_ of Sight
  - a. Christ's Continued Ministry to the Man - 25a

Made him look up (*dia-blep-o*) -  
"To see with a p\_\_\_\_\_ gaze"

b. His Vision is c\_\_\_\_\_ - v. 25b  
saw everyone/everything clearly - "see clearly" *em-blep'-o* - to fix one's eyes, to see clearly, perfectly,

From Anablepo to Diablepo to Emblepo. A very fast but also progressive gift of sight.

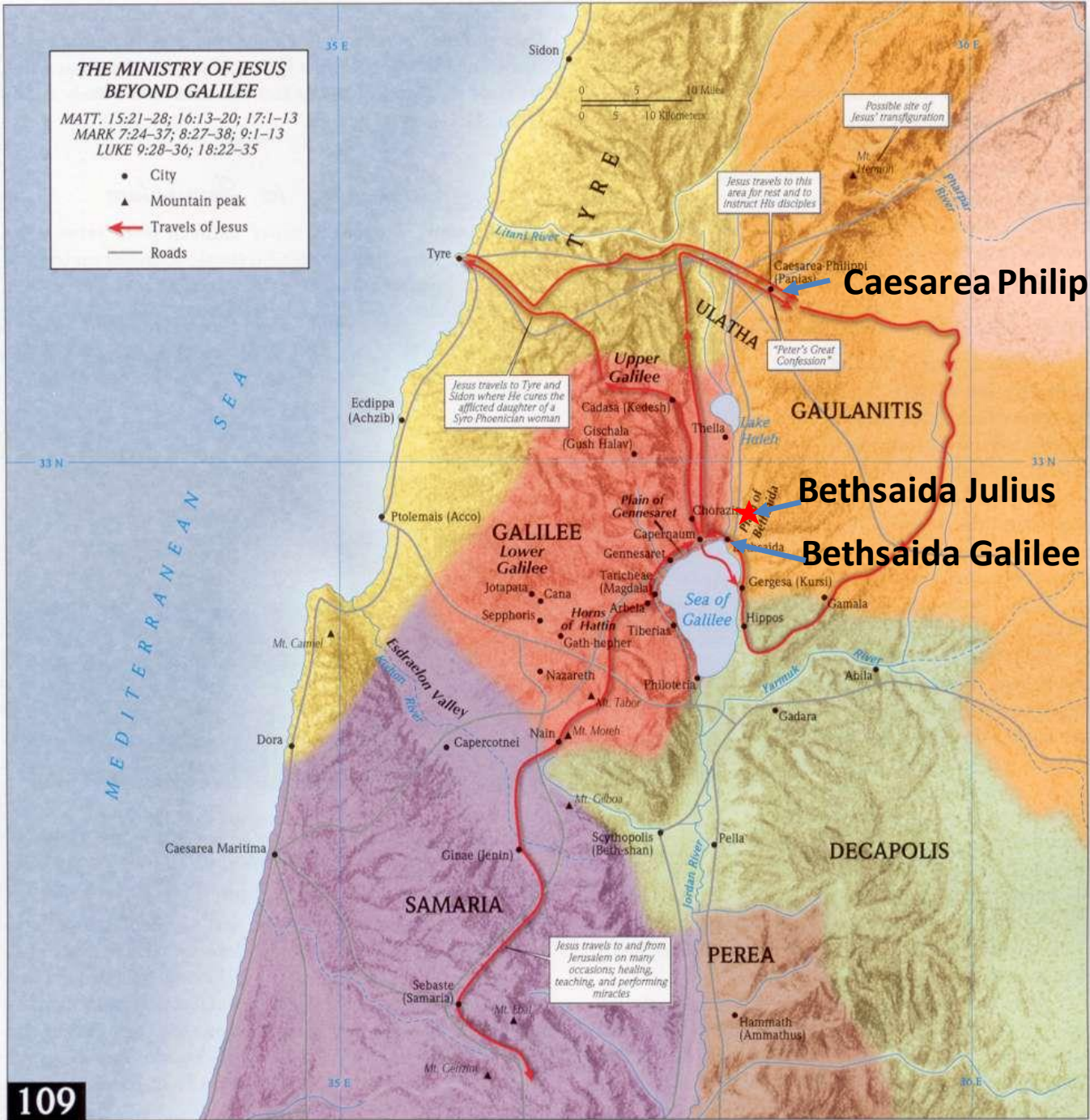
