No Condemnation in Christ Jesus! Rom. 8:1-4
The calling of an expositor is to explain and apply the
Spurgeon, "The fact is, that believers are in a state of conflict, but in a state of
condemnation."
The little adverb "now" is a massive
"No condemnation" is what he needs to
Adam's brought condemnation to us (5:16, 18a)
Our own sins deserve judgment, indeed His condemnation.
We are under condemnation right now if we have not Christ
NO condemnation. This is the verdict!!!
No condemnation means
a) No sin in Adam to condemn
b) No sins I have committed can condemn
c) No lack of righteousness can condemn
d) No condemnation right now and no condemnation on the Last
In Christ Jesus is to be in with Christ Jesus
Jesus kept the Law for me – so the cannot condemn me.
Jesus paid the penalty of my sin – so there is not penalty for me to
Jesus bore the wrath of God in my place – there is no for me to face.
The curse of Adam's sin has been taken away and I am now a creation in
Christ Jesus (2 Cor. 5:17).
Because it is true now, it will be true on the Last
