Theme: What response to your enemies glorifies God?

Consider this verse that all people are part of the human race

**Acts 17:26** And hath made of one **blood** all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the earth...

I. The example of responding to your enemies

Esth 3:6 And he thought scorn to lay hands on Mordecai alone; for they had shewed him the people of Mordecai: WHEREFORE Haman sought to destroy all the Jews...

In chapter 4 it all comes to a head. How will they respond to their enemies?

They appealed to God in prayer
They appealed to the "government" by petition

## II. The exhortation regarding responding to your enemies

## (v. 8) These are absolute truths

- 1. You can force someone to obey, but you can't make them change
- 2. You can't keep yourself from death
- 3. You can't use evil to defeat evil
