## **Conclusions:**

- 1) In the Old Testament, the function of the Holy Spirit was different.
- 2) In the New Testament, the Holy Spirit personally indwells believers.
- 3) This transition was prophesied in the Old Testament.
- 4) There were some saints in the transition period between Old and New Testaments who received the Holy Spirit after Pentecost.
- 5) The position of Bethel Christian Church is that the Holy Spirit is given at salvation, and a second work of grace is not the current norm.
- 6) While there is not a second work of grace where more of the Holy Spirit is given to believers, there are varying degrees to which Christians are yielded to the Holy Spirit.
