Introduction: "Tradition" - Its importance and place: Some "traditions" are worth keeping

I. Living in Christ

A. You received

1. What has been passed down - Jesus in my heart?
    - a. More than "inviting Jesus into my heart and life"
    - b. A more technical term from Judaism
      - The passing of teaching from one generation to another  
(Deuteronomy 6:1-15; 1 Corinthians 11:2; 15:1-5; 2 Thessalonians 3:6)
  2. Your sure foundation
    - Is Christ Jesus the Lord (Hebrews 13:8; 1 Corinthians 3:11)
    - By faith – received
- B. So walk - Colossians 1:10 "so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord,..."

II. Growing in Christ

- A mixed metaphor? (1 Corinthians 3:9)

A. Deep roots

1. This life is something entirely new!
  - a. Uprooted from old life
    - NOTE: Apart from Christ, the "roots" ultimately wrap around "me."
  - b. New environment, new foundation
    - Rich, deep, solid
    - Rooted in the divine - not the temporal!
    - Rooted in a Person!
2. Holding onto the Son - Dependent upon Christ Jesus, the Lord!
  - NOTE: There is nothing stagnant about being "rooted" in Christ.

B. Being built (Colossians 1:10) - So we grow!

1. "Building up"
  - a. In the worldly sense?
    - The cult of "self-esteem"
    - The antidote? Romans 12:3; Philippians 2:3
    - NOTE: We will be attacked for not acknowledging or serving the god of self-esteem.
  - b. In a Godly sense - 1:10 Bearing fruit!
2. "In Him"
  - a. The danger? - Growth in "knowledge," but not growing "in Him"
  - b. The delight - Reflecting the life of the One who is "in us"

III. Knowing More of Christ

A. You were taught - Paul shared what had been given (entrusted) to him (Philippians 4:9)

B. Make it your own - established/strengthened in the faith

1. Salvation is the beginning (Hebrews 6:1, 2)
  - a. We must learn the faith
  - b. Using the means he has given
2. We must live the faith

#### IV. To His Glory – Conclusion

- A. Pass on the traditions of Christ Jesus the Lord!
- B. Put yourself in the place to receive the "traditions" that have been passed down.
- C. Don't take the Christian Life for granted.
- D. Pray that the Lord will establish you (and us) in him so that we may stand secure in the world and walk joyfully and confidently in him all our days.
