Main Point:

Since Jesus is the promised Son of David, submit to Him and give Him your worship.

1. Jesus is the promised Son of David.

2. As the promised Son of David, Jesus is the King of kings.

3. As the promised Son of David, Jesus is the Savior of sinners.

4. Submit to the promised Son of David and give Him your worship.

2 Samuel 7:12-13 ¹² "When your days are fulfilled and you rest with your fathers, I will set up your seed after you, who will come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. ¹³ "He shall build a house for My name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. (NKJV)
