- I. Jesus as the True Vine (vs. 1)
 - A. This is an I AM statement
 - B. Jeremiah 2:21
 - 1. Though they (as branches/born into the Jewish family) came from the Vine, they were not in the Vine.
 - C. God the Father tends the vine ensuring and insuring that those who are in the Vine remain on the Vine.
- II. The Vine Dresser and the branches (vs. 2-8)
 - A. Fruit bearers
 - 1. God will remove all things in a believers life that will hinder them from growing.
 - a) If it does not bring Him glory, He will remove it from your life.(1) Hebrews 12:1-11
 - b) Trust that he will do this in all Christian lives
 - 2. Abide (to stay) in the True Vine. Not to be saved, but to produce fruit (sanctification).
 - 3. Everyday that He works in us, He brings us into maturity.
 - B. Barren Branches
 - 1. Those who say, "Lord, Lord."
 - a) Matthew 7:21-23
 - 2. Those who tasted, but did not consume
 - a) Hebrews 6:4-8
