there. (Ecclesiastes 3:16)	
Ah sinful nation, a people laden with iniquity,	
a seed of evildoers, children that are corrupters: they have forsaken the LORD, they have	
provoked the Holy One of Israel unto anger, they are gone away backward.	
Why should ye be stricken any more? ye will	
revolt more and more: the whole head is sick, and the whole heart faint.	
From the sole of the foot even unto the head	
there is no soundness in it; but wounds, and bruises, and putrifying sores: they have not	
been closed, neither bound up, neither molli-	
fied with ointment. (Isaiah 1:4-6)	
Bring no more vain oblations; incense is an	
abomination unto me; the new moons and	
sabbaths, the calling of assemblies, I cannot away with; it is iniquity, even the solemn meet-	
ing. (Isaiah 1:13)

(Psalm 94:20) For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones. For the iniquity of his covetousness was I wroth... (Isaiah 57:15, 17) 4. O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker. For he is our God; and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand. To day if ye will hear his voice, (Psalm 95:6-7) **5**. For he flattereth himself in his own eyes, until his iniquity be found to be hateful. The words of his mouth are iniquity and deceit: he hath left off to be wise, and to do good. He deviseth mischief upon his bed; (Psalm 36:2-4) How long shall they utter and speak hard things? and all the workers of iniquity boast themselves? They break in pieces thy people, O LORD, and afflict thine heritage. (Psalm 94:4-5) When the wicked spring as the grass, and when all the workers of iniquity do flourish; it is that they shall be destroyed for ever: But thou, LORD, art most high for evermore. For, lo, thine enemies, O LORD, for, lo, thine enemies shall perish; all the workers of iniquity shall be scattered. (Psalm 92:7-9) For I have told him that I will judge his house for ever for the iniquity which he knoweth; because his sons made themselves vile, and he restrained them not. (1 Samuel 3:13) 8. ...for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness. (Romans 6:19)

Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;

And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments. (Exodus 20:5-6)
