### INTRODUCTION

- 1. "Quest narrative". Drama- value of goal juxtaposed w/ possible failure.
- 2. Rv 5:1-7 greatest of all quests: Son of God Messianic Mission

## 1st: The Command to Stop Weeping

- 1.  $\underline{\text{Rv } 5:4}$  cry of fallen man; sounds of heaven [4:8-11] & earth {Gn 4:10].
- 2. Jn: a man w/o hope, wailing of despair [Eph 2:12]
- **3**. 1st Adam failed but Jesus, the Last Adam has succeeded Sabbath Rest.
- 4. Stop weeping the tears of despair!

### 2nd: Look at the Triumphant Lion/Lamb: the Resurrected Jesus

- 1. Behold v5-6. Davidic King is Sacrificial Lamb: has overcome.
- **2.** He accomplished work of atonement. Blood of lamb not on earthly propitiation seat Lamb Himself sits on heavenly throne! Ps 97:2; Isa 16:5
- **3**. Jesus' worthiness as our covenantal head: established righteousness: Heb 1:8 *righteous scepter*; Rv 4:11 as God, He is *worthy*: glorified Son of Man.
- 4. The true Adamic man obtains the hope established in creation.

## 3rd: The Lamb is the Enthroned Sovereign Lord: Coronation of King Jesus

- 1. Heavenly throne-room:  $\underline{4:2}$ . Focus on enthroned One & His right hand:  $\underline{5:1}$
- 2. v6 Lamb near & moving towards the throne: 4:6-7

- -0i. He came & took = past completed action => answer to v2's question

  ii. Dan 7:13-14 Lamb Son of Man Adamic man [dominion].
- **3**. Rv 5:1 & 5:7 focus on scroll: administer decreed history. Heaven worships.
- **4**. Lamb begins a new chapter in His reign over creation: coronated as King.

i. Lk 1:32-33 throne of His father David & He will reign... forever

ii. <u>A 2:32-36</u> - fulfill Ps 110

iii. Eph 1:18-23 the Lord of Creation is our Redeemer
 iv. Hb 1:3b; 8:1-2 reign of Melchizedekan King/Priest
 v. 1T 6:15b-16 doxology - praise the coronated King

- 5. Where is Jesus? Rv 3:21 note verb tense: past acts
  i. Rv 7:17 Lamb seated on His throne = Shepherd
  ii. Rv 22:1-3 single throne singular occupant: God &
- 6. What is Jesus doing? Rm 8:34b

# Appic #1: Stop Weeping Because Our Eschatological Hope is Secure

- 1. Lk 6:21, 25; Rv 6:9-10 Jesus wept [Jn 11:35]. Christians cry.
- 2. Why did John cry? W/o hope weep in Rv 18 destruction of Babylon
- 3. Beware of truncated eschatologies Satan's strategy: contains hope w/i this age & falls short of res glory. Results in "shame" eschatological defeat.

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- 4. All depends of Jesus' resurrection 1 C 15:13-28 1st-fruit [Eph 2:4-7].
- 5. We are united to resurrected enthroned Jesus live by faith 1Jn 3:2.
- 6. Stop weeping: our eschatological hope is secure.

# Applic #2: Cultivate Kingdom Joy

- 1. *Behold* Lion/Lamb. We will cry but not the tears that John cries in Rv 5:4. The Spirit will teach us to cry for the things for wh/ Jesus cried [Hb 12:2]
- 2. <u>1Pt 1:8</u> *great inexpressible glorious joy* joy of conscience that knows no condemnation; joyful peace of Jesus. *My peace I give to you* [Jn 14:26-27]
  - i. We often tell Jesus where He shld look. Angel says behold!
  - ii. Internalize the means of grace precisely, focused faith in worship.
  - iii. Witness testify to others & experience joy of conquest: love enemies
- **3.** Jesus' grand quest has been successful. We, in Him by HS, are on our quest. Live in the reality of HIS success.
