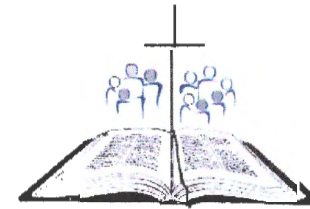

WE AFFIRM THE "SOLAS" OF THE PROTESTANT REFORMATION:

- **Sola Scriptura (Scripture Alone):** The Bible is the sole written divine revelation and alone can bind the conscience of believers absolutely.
- **Sola Fide (Faith Alone):** Justification is by faith alone. The merit of Christ, imputed to us by faith, is the sole ground of our acceptancy by God, by which our sins are remitted and imputed to Christ.
- **Solus Christus (Christ Alone):** Christ is the only mediator Whose work we are redeemed.
- **Sola Gratia (Grace Alone):** Our salvation rests solely on the work of God's grace for us.
- **Soli Deo Gloria (To the Glory of God Alone):** To God alone belongs the glory.

THE WESTMINSTER SHORTER CATECHISM:

Q25: How doth Christ execute the office of a priest?

A.: Christ executeth the office of a priest, in His once offering up of Himself a sacrifice to satisfy divine justice, and reconcile us to God, and in making continual intercession for us.

Q26: How doth Christ execute the office of a king?

A: Christ executeth the office of a king, in subduing us to Himself, in ruling and defending us, and in restraining and conquering all His and our enemies.
