- 1. Atmosphere: grace surrounds us. Inclusios book-ends of Paul's letters: begin *grace be to you* & conclude w/ *grace be with you*. Grace is the atmosphere for the life of faith.

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- 2. We receive grace by faith in Christ & we live by grace thru faith in Christ.
- 3. Mt 15:13 a disciple = a plant planted by Father.
 - i. v7-11 Phars to be uprooted for hypocrisy.
 - ii. v15-20 our words = evidence of life of the heart
 - iii. Recall parable of sower/soils. 1 Cor 3:6-7.

Applic #1: Grace Explains Why You Are a Christian

- 1. Why are you a believer? GRACE. Eph 2:4-10
- 2. There is not place for pride; for boasting [1C 4:7]; *let him who boasts, boast in the Lord* [1C 1:31; 2C 10:17] Jer 9:23-24. Why are you a Christian? God's *lovingkindness* God's *delight*.
