Mark 7:7 Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.

The Torah: Torah technically refers to the first five books of the Hebrew Bible (Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy). However, it colloquially refers to all 24 books of the Hebrew Bible, also called the **Tanakh**.

The Talmud: The Talmud is the compilation of the historic rabbis discussing or debating" what the Torah means. Also known as the Oral Torah. Many Jews call it inspired. The Talmud was written after the life of Christ. It is written cryptically so as to require a Rabbi to teach it, thus maintaining the idea of being oral.

- The Talmud says that Jesus was a child of adultery. He was the son of a soldier by the name of Panthera. Jesus spent his early life in Egypt where he practiced black magic, idolatry, and sorcery.
- The Talmud goes on to say that Jesus was a fool and that he finds himself in the not particularly flattering company of Balaam, Ahithophel, Doeg, and Gehazi.
- A passage from Sanhedrin 106 gloats over the early age at which Jesus died: "Hast thou heard how old Balaam (Jesus) was?--He replied: It is not actually stated but since it is written, Bloody and deceitful men shall not live out half their days it follows that he was thirty-three or thirty-four years old."
- Erubin 21b. Whosoever disobeys the rabbis deserves death and will be punished by being boiled in hot excrement in hell. Gittin 57a. Says Jesus is being boiled in "hot excrement."


Kabbalah: Sometimes translated as "mysticism" or "occult knowledge"—is a part of Jewish tradition that deals with the essence of God. Originally developed within the realm of Jewish tradition. Kabbalah seeks to define the nature of the universe and the human being, the nature and purpose of existence, and various other questions. The Zohar, a collection of written, mystical commentaries on the Torah, is considered to be the underpinning of Kabbalah.

Popular Jewish Beliefs: They do not believe in creation, Adam and Eve, Noah's flood, the Tower of Babel, or a literal Hell.

Star of David? Israel Ministry of Foreign Affairs: "Unlike the menorah, the Lion of Judah, the shofar and the lulav, the Star of David was never uniquely a Jewish symbol." The symbol became representative of the worldwide Zionist community after it was chosen as the central symbol on a flag at the First Zionist Congress in 1897. It was known as the Seal of Solomon among Muslims. Kabbalists adopted it for use in talismanic protective




amulets. The Masonic lodge uses the same symbol. It is known as the Eastern Star; a reference to the star, Sirius, which is the most significant star in Satanism! The Eastern Star is the star of Set, the Egyptian god of chaos (aka Moloch, Chiun, Remphan).



Amos 5:26 But ye have borne the tabernacle of your **Moloch** and **Chiun** your images, **the star of your god**, which ye made to yourselves

Acts 7:42-43 Yea, ye took up the tabernacle of **Moloch**, and **the star of your god Remphan**, figures which ye made to worship them: and I will carry you away beyond Babylon.



Solomon married many outlandish (Ne.13:26) women and became an idolator (1Ki 11:1-11). He is connected with 666 in scripture (1Ki 10:14, 2Ch 9:13). It is possible that Solomon purposely budgeted for 666 talents of gold because of his worship of the star god.

The "Seal of Solomon" has six points, forms six equilateral triangles, and its interior forms a six-sided hexagon — thus it reveals the number 666.

Shechinah שכינה: The Shechinah glory is taught by ignorant Christians as the glory of the Lord found in 2 Chron. 7:1 (even though the term is not found in the bible). But Shechinah is the pre-eminent feminine aspect of God as stated in Judaism, "...so when we refer to God as the Shechinah, we say 'She.' Of course, we're still referring to the same One God, just in a different modality."

Shechinah is derived from the word *shochen* שכן, "to dwell within." The Shechinah is believed to be God *dwelling within*. Sometimes it is translated as "The Divine Presence." It is a teaching in both the Talmud and in Kabbalah.

Medieval Kabbalists often portrayed the feminine Shechinah as a loving mother who suffers along with her children Israel in exile. Today feminist theologians and earth-centered Jews have reclaimed the Shekhinah as a unified deity in her own right, dwelling within living things and the earth, seeking peace and promoting human connection, speaking through women as well as men, working through the neglected and invisible, promoting change and healing brokenness. She is the Goddess—an image of the forces of life and the mysteries of creation. The Shekhinah, for some, is a reminder that there is no division between creation and divinity. The Shekhinah allows us to break through the exclusively male and hierarchical visions of God and imagine a God that changes as we change, that evokes nature as well as the supernatural.

Mt 23:15 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the **child of hell** than yourselves.

John 5:45-47 Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father: there is *one* that accuseth you, *even* Moses, in whom ye trust. **For had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed me:** for he wrote of me. But if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe my words?

John 8:37-38 I know that ye are Abraham's seed; but ye seek to kill me, **because my word hath no place in you.** I speak that which I have seen with my Father: and ye do that which ye have seen with your father.

Jesus reveals that not only did the Jews rejected him, but they rejected Moses and the heavenly Father.

Paul Warns of the Jews Religion

Titus 1:10-11 For there are many unruly and vain talkers and deceivers, **specially they of the circumcision:** Whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole houses, teaching things which they ought not, **for filthy lucre's sake.**

Philippians 3:18-19 (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, *that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ:* Whose end *is* destruction, whose God *is* their belly, and *whose* glory *is* in their shame, who mind earthly things.)

Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath **bewitched you**, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?

But God is Not Done with the Jews. Replacement theology teaches that the church replaces Israel and claims their promises. This wrong division of scripture brings about hatred for the Jews and kingdom building.

Romans 11:25 For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, **until** the fulness of the Gentiles be come in.

Heb 8:10-13 For this *is* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people: **11** And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest. **12** For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more. **13** In that he saith, A new *covenant*, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old *is* ready to vanish away.

Revelation 7:3-4 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads. And I heard the number of them which were sealed: *and there were* sealed an hundred *and* forty *and* four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.
