Gospel of John: Purpose - We should Believe & have Eternal Life John 20:31

Epistles of John: Purpose - We have Assurance & Knowledge 1 John 5:13

Gospel: Historical facts - Eternal Life was manifested by the Son of God.

And we may share in that Life . . . by believing. John 3:16, 6:68, 10:28

Epistles: Theme is still Eternal Life

- but here it's manifested in us : the children of God

Gospel: John reveals the <u>key</u> = grace and truth

John 1:1 & 14

Epistles: 1 John will focus on the power of grace in the believers life.

2 & 3 John will emphasize the necessity of truth in a believers life.

Johns Epistles provide both doctrine and duty.

They afford us with both teaching, and a test.

They teach us what eternal life is in the experience of a child of God.

And enable us to test ourselves and know that we have eternal life.

Johns Epistles also emphasize fellowship. (an essential, central doctrine)

1. Fellowship with God 1 John 1:3

fellowship with brethren
 John 1:7

3. avoid fellowship with error 1 John 4:1 & 6

Eternal life is given in Christ, and John highlights Christ's twofold essence: light & love.

Light - 1 John 1:5, 2:20, 2:27 light ~ knowledge ~ truth

Life - 1 Joh 4:7-9 & 20-21 love ~ service ~ grace

In Christ we see: the sunshine of sinless heavenly light and the sacrificial service of true selfless love.

Eternal life is grace life . . . it's true life . . . life as God intended it to be. John 10:10
