 - 1. Written mid 50s AD (Mark and Luke mid 60s, John mid 80s)
 - 2. Longest, Most Jewish, Most Evangelistic
 - 3. Over 40 Old Testament Quotations
 - 4. "All this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophets" appears 16 times
 - 5. Only gospel to use the word "church" Matt. 16:18; 18:17
 - a. Ekklesia called out, gathered assembly
 - b. A regularly attended public meeting
 - B. David and Abraham
 - 1. David Israel's greatest king, demonstrating Jesus' right to rule 2 Sam. 7:16
 - 2. Abraham Israel's father, through Jesus blessing all the nations Gen. 12:3

 - a. Matthew reveals to us the King revealed, rejected, and returning. JM
 - b. Isaiah = Behold Your God; Matthew = Behold Your King Matt. 2:2
